2016 In New Zealand, the government revised its national curriculum for early childhood education called Te Whāriki, which was originally formed in 1996. The revision was taken place to reflect its social change and to make the curriculum holistic to include the connections of early childhood learnings to elementary schools. (Pioneer Kids had translated Te Whāriki in to Japanese in October 2011 and implemented in the nursery activities.) Given this revision of Te Whāriki, we also revised the curriculum for Pioneer Kids.
